



FOR INDOOR OR OUTDOOR USE

- Any room in the house
- Patio, porch and garden
- Near garbage containers
 Inside barns, kennels, stables, coops
- Picnic and recreational areas

DIRECTIONS

DO NOT TOUCH the sticky yellow cylinder. If you do, use vegetable oil and soap with warm water to remove the glue.

You can keep each trap inside its individual cardboard box and remove the perforated front section of the box, exposing only the front of the trap. This is ideal if you want the trap placed more discreetly. Also, it reduces the chance of accidentally touching the sticky part.

Alternatively you can remove each trap completely from its individual box. This is the most effective way to use the trap as all sides of the sticky cylinder will be fully exposed.

Each trap can be placed on a flat surface, or hung from the plastic hook at the top.

You can hang the trap with or without its individual box. If you want to keep the trap in its box while you hang it, feed the hook though the slit in the top of the box.

CAUTION:

Keep out of reach of children and pets. In case of contact with adhesive, use vegetable oil with soap and warm water.

DISPOSAL:

Replace every 3 months or when the stick is full of flying insects. Remove and wrap in a newspaper and dispose of in trash.

Use sweet or acidic bait like:

- Fruit
- Vinegar
- Syrup
- White wine

Use smelly food bait like:

- Tuna
- Cat food
- Pieces of meat
